This winter we had fun learning about instrument families. It was fun trying out and listening to the sounds of different instruments and we enjoyed having a percussion parade. In March we are listening to classical music and deciding if it sounds like a lion or lamb. Spring is a great time to learn new songs about rabbits, birds, rain and planting seeds as well as try out some new instruments like shaker eggs and rhythm sticks. We are thrilled to be able to share some of our favorite songs with you at the Spring Program this May.
