Welcome to Bally Community Preschool! We are committed to providing an excellent early childhood education experience for 3-5 year olds so that they can learn and grow in a supportive, loving Christian environment. We desire that children develop a love of learning and a positive self-image tied to an appreciation of their relationships with a loving God, other people, and God's creation.

We strive to create a stimulating, multi-sensory environment that encourages the growth of the whole child: spiritually, socially, emotionally, physically and intellectually. We aim to provide a balance of experiences: individual and group learning opportunities, child-initiated and teacher-directed activities, active and quiet times, outdoor and indoor play, large and small muscle practice. Spanish and music classes are offered each week. We have designed our classroom environment to encourage learning in ways that comply with the Pennsylvania Standards for Early Childhood Education. A quality Christian preschool experience is an excellent investment in your child's future.

Our classes are held on Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 – 11:30 AM or 12:30 – 3:00 PM for three-year-olds and on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 – 11:30 AM or 12:30 – 3:00 PM for four-year-olds. Afternoon classes are contingent upon enrollment. The school year will be from early September to late May.

Our director and head teacher is our three-year-old teacher, Mrs. Cindy Roma. Mrs. Roma holds a bachelor's degree in elementary and early childhood education as well as a master's degree in elementary education. She has worked at BCP since 2009. We are also pleased to have Mrs. Carol Gehman as our four-year-old teacher. Mrs. Gehman has a bachelor's degree in both early childhood and elementary education. She has worked at BCP since 2007.

Bally Community Preschool – Application Information

- *Age of Children:* Your child must be 3 on or before September 1st to enroll in the Three-Year-Old class and 4 on or before September 1st to enroll in the Four-Year-Old class. It is a requirement that all children be toilet trained.
 - *School Hours:* Tuesday and Thursday – Three-Year-Old Class – 9:00-11:30 AM *or* 12:30 – 3:00 PM
Monday, Wednesday, and Friday – Four-Year-Old Class – 9:00-11:30 AM *or* 12:30 – 3:00 PM
Note: Afternoon classes for both 3s and 4s are contingent upon enrollment.
 - *School Calendar:* School will be held from September until the end of May. (Closings for Holidays, Parent/Teacher conferences, etc. are listed on the school calendar and will be included in your enrollment packet.)
 - *Size of Class:* Three-Year-Old Program (T-TH): 15 children
Four-Year-Old Program (M-W-F): 18 children
 - *School Staff:* A certified teacher and an aide will conduct each class.

 - *Mission Statement:*
To provide an excellent early childhood education experience for 3-5 year olds so that they can learn and grow in a Christian environment. We desire for children to develop a love of learning and a positive self-image tied to an appreciation of their relationships with a loving God, other people, and God's creation.
 - *We Will:*
 1. Create an environment where each child feels safe, nurtured, loved, and excited about the life God has given, based on Biblical values.
 2. Offer opportunities for academic growth through manipulatives*, language development, math concepts, science activities, artistic expression, and musical experiences.
 3. Provide large- and small-motor development activities and supervised playtime indoors and out.
 4. Model and encourage friendship, independence, responsibility, curiosity, problem solving, and respect for others.

* manipulatives = materials designed to encourage self-directed exploration and learning
 - *Tuition Fees:*
Three-Year-Old Class (2 days/week) = yearly tuition of \$1100.00 (\$110.00 per month, payable in 10 monthly payments for your convenience)
Four-Year-Old Class (3 days/week) = yearly tuition of \$1500.00 (\$150.00 per month, payable in 10 monthly payments for your convenience)
- Payments are due on the first of the month. A non-refundable registration fee of \$50.00 is due with your child's completed registration form. Please inquire about other payment options and discounts (i.e.: discount for siblings and/or single, lump-sum payment).
